Critical workers and vulnerable in school provision

Dear Parents and Carers,

Thank you for your cooperation in ensuring that we have had a smooth start to our new way of working. I apologise that I am only just getting this information out to you; however, the last couple of days have been rather busy.

During their time in school, the children will remain as a small group of approximately 10-15 children. They will be working with children from their own class with the class teacher and teaching assistant. The 'bubble' approach will continue with children not mixing across the school. Children will remain with their group at lunchtime and break times and have an allocated area to play in.

The drop off and collection times are going to continue to be staggered and will remain the same as before Christmas.

Clothing

Children are to wear their school uniform to school. We will be continuing to have the windows open to allow adequate ventilation so if your child would like to bring a jumper to wear, in addition to their school jumper, that will be fine.

Lunch

Our arrangements for lunchtime are the same as when we have the whole school here. We are continuing to cook hot school meals on site throughout this time of partial school opening. If your child is in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2, they are able to have a hot school meal provided free of charge as they would usually. Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6, who are entitled to free school meals, will also have a meal provided. Children in Years 3, 4, 5 and 6 are also able to order a hot meal and this can be paid for using School Money. If any child would prefer a packed lunch, this is to be provided by yourself. It is essential that all children bring a water bottle to school, which can be refilled if necessary. The water fountains will not be in use during this time.



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Illness

If your child requires first aid at school, wherever possible they will be encouraged to carry this out themselves under the supervision, guidance and reassurance from a member of staff. We understand though that this will not always be possible. If close contact care is required, PPE will be worn by staff to ensure the first aid is provided safely.

Please could you ensure the following steps continue to be taken to support our health and safety in school;

- If your child or a member of your household has symptoms and is awaiting a test result, please inform the office and do not send your child to school until a negative result is obtained. We would be very grateful if you could call the school office to make us aware of the test outcome before your child returns to school.
- If your child receives a positive COVID result, please inform school as soon as possible. The admin email admin.asf@ebor.academy is checked regularly over the weekend so that communication to isolate can be swift.

Thank you for your cooperation.

We are committed to ensuring that all children, either in school or working remotely, receive an excellent quality of education and will ensure that there is continuity to enable children to switch from both methods if necessary.
