

English

Having had access to a wide range of text types, genres and authors through the teaching of reading at All Saints' children will be able to express preferences and opinions about the texts that they read. We want our children to write with confidence and accuracy for a variety of purposes, audiences and forms whilst developing their own individual flair. Children will have the confidence to be able to write with grammatical accuracy and apply spelling patterns correctly, whilst using a neat handwriting style. Through a variety of texts and genres we aim to expose our children to a wide range of vocabulary so that they are able to decipher new words and then use them when speaking both informally and formally.

Maths

As mathematicians we aim to be fluent in reasoning and problem solving as we approach challenges with confidence and independence. Our vision is that children will be fluent in the basic skills of mathematics including additive facts and multiplicative facts. They will be able to apply these facts to enable them to reason mathematically and solve problems. They will show perseverance when solving both routine and non-routine problems and have the self belief that they can develop an in-depth knowledge of mathematics.

Science

At All Saints' CE Federation of Academies, we recognise the invaluable role that science plays within the school curriculum and everyday life in understanding the world around us. Our children have a variety of practical, first hand experiences, which develop a natural curiosity, and an understanding of working scientifically. Children use these skills covering a range of exciting topics each year, building on their prior knowledge.

PE

Our high-quality PE curriculum is designed to inspire all pupils to develop and excel in a wide range of physical activities. It promotes a healthy and active lifestyle through engaging in competitive sports and other physically demanding activities, which allows the children to aspire to work to their full potential, both physically and mentally. Opportunities to compete in sport and other physical activities also forms part of our Christian ethos by encouraging children to be Respectful, Independent, Confident, Happy, Enthusiastic and Resilient.

RE

At All Saints' CE Federation of Academies, we intend for our Religious Education curriculum to help children to acquire and develop knowledge and understanding of Christianity as well as other principal religions represented locally, nationally and globally.
