
Hello Yellow Day

Please can I remind you of the start times at the Infant and Junior Schools.

Junior School - Children are to enter school from **8:35am - 8:45am**. At 8:45am the gate on Northolme Road is locked. The gate on Eastgate is locked very soon after this time. Parents leaving the playground after this time will be asked to leave via the car park entrance.
