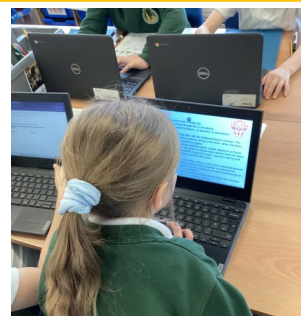
We are especially proud of our School Parliament. We consider it very important that the children have a voice in the running of our school and feel empowered to bring about positive change.

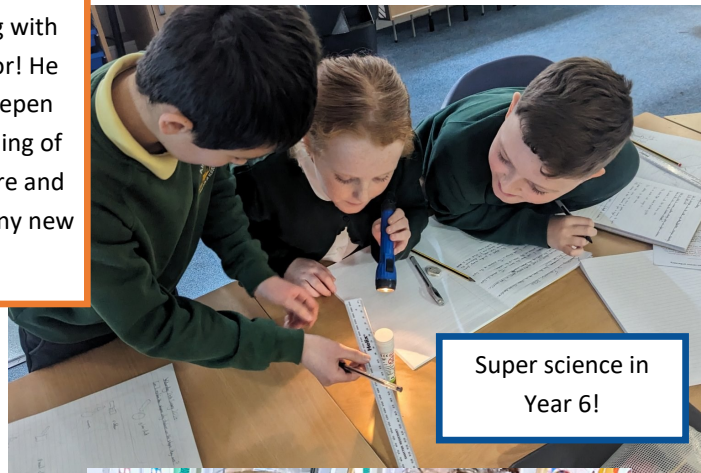

Year 1 have become Titanic experts!

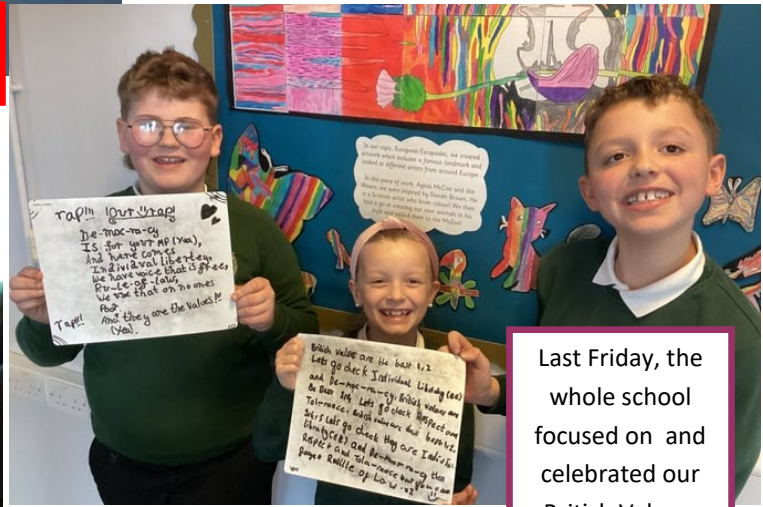
