

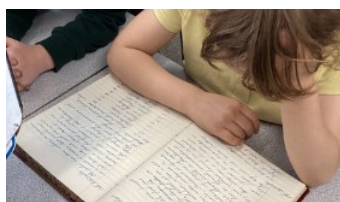

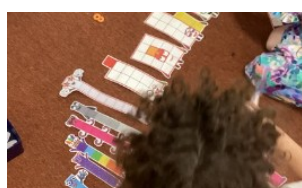
In the next newsletter, I should be in a position to share the class organisation and teaching structure for the coming year along with the transition arrangements.

## School Uniform

We expect children to wear school uniform, as we feel that this encourages a sense of belonging and pride in the school. We are sharing a reminder about uniform expectations in preparation for the start of the new school term in September.

### **Winter/Summer**

- Grey or black trousers/shorts/skorts/skirt/pinafore dress
- White or yellow polo shirt/white shirt/blouse
- Bottle green pullover, cardigan or sweatshirt

### **Summer**

- Summer dress in check pattern green/white or yellow/white



School footwear should be predominantly black. Croc style shoes are NOT suitable for school.

A PE kit is needed in school on a daily basis. A PE kit should include: black shorts, jogging bottoms or leggings, a plain white t-shirt, a plain black or green hoodie/jumper/cardigan and a change of footwear [trainers or sand shoes]

Items of school clothing with the school logo are available from Audrey Mansell's, but are not essential.

Jewellery is not normally permitted. A pair of stud earrings may be worn, but must be removed/covered for PE. Watches, for telling the time, are also allowed. Hair accessories should reflect school colours and should not distract others from learning.
