Friends of All Saints' Spring Discos - Year 2, Year 4 and Years 6

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Friends of All Saints' will soon be holding the first discos of the year. Discos for children in Year 2, 4 and 6 will take place this half term. Discos for children in Year 3 and Year 5 will take place next half term. An event for children in Nursery, Reception and Year 1 has been planned for later in the year.

The **Year 2** disco will take place straight after school in the Junior School Hall on **Tuesday 3rd February**. Children attending will be taken to the disco at the end of the school day by school adults and should be collected by parents or carers from the Junior School Office at 4.45pm. Year 2 children will need to bring a change of clothes in a named carrier bag and will get changed prior to the disco starting.

The **Year 6** disco will also take place on **Tuesday 3rd February**, but at the later time of **5:15pm**. Children from Year 6 should be dropped off at the Junior School Office at 5.15pm and they will need to be collected at 6.30pm; **children will not be allowed to walk home alone**.

The **Year 4** disco will take place straight after school in the Junior School Hall on **Thursday 5th February**. Children attending will be taken to the disco at the end of the school day by their class teacher and should be collected by parents or carers from the Junior School Office at 4.45pm. Year 4 children will need to bring a change of clothes in a named carrier bag and will get changed prior to the disco starting.

We understand that some children sometimes find these events overwhelming. Please be assured that a quieter space will also be available for those children who may need it during the event.

The cost of the event is **£2.50** per child and this will include a drink, a packet of crisps and some sweets for your child to enjoy. We do understand that for some families £2.50 is a lot of money and you may find this a struggle, so please don't hesitate to speak to the school or a member of the FOAS in confidence if your child would like to attend.

To pay for the disco, you will receive a notification via text/email from School Money in the same way that you do for trips/lunches etc. If you do not wish for your child to attend the disco, please ignore this message. The final date to book your place for these disco events is **Monday 26th January**, to give us time to plan accordingly and purchase the correct stock. **You will be unable to book a place after this date.**

If any parent/guardian would also like to volunteer at future events, please let us know at foas@ebor.academy or join our Facebook group 'Friends Of All Saints Federation' and send us a message. A DBS clearance is required for all volunteers, this can be organised by school, and there will be some online training to complete.
