British Science Week is a ten-day celebration of science, technology, engineering and maths [STEM] that will take place from 6th -15th March! During the week of 9th March, the children will learn more about how science, technology, engineering and maths are used in real life contexts as well as completing investigations to inspire and engage learning. There will also be a range of activities taking place in major cities. Across the UK.

Colliderfest, a 'four-day science and arts extravaganza' will take place in Hull City Centre from 12th - 15th March, and will include "a large scale evening spectacle of light installations trailing across the city centre", as well as lots of other workshops and events—some free, some ticketed.
