Hull and East Riding Swimming Event

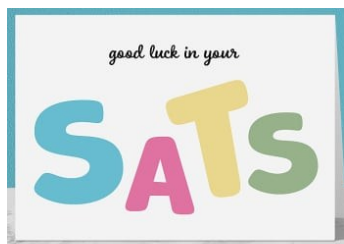

Or the kindness in your heart.

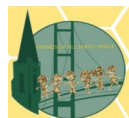
SATs don't see your beauty,
