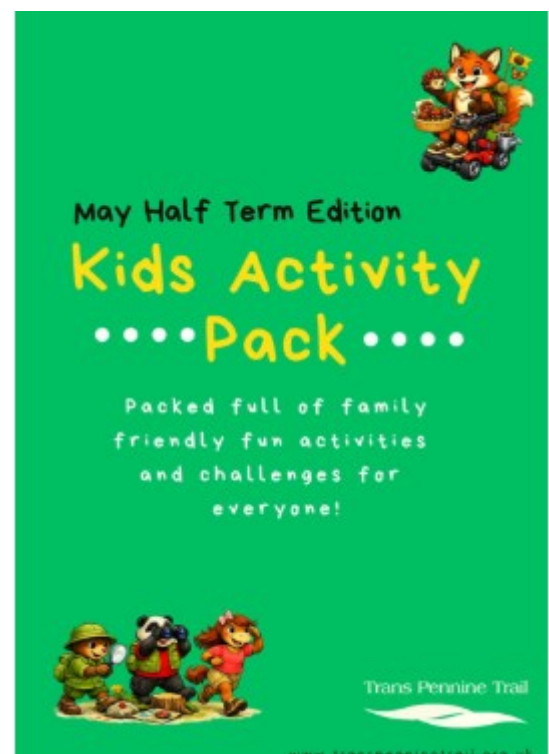

OSCAR's Charity Clay Shoot & Family Fun Day - Saturday 27th June

The event is an OSCAR's Charity Clay Shoot & Family Fun Day and promises to be a fantastic day for all ages, with everything from bouncy castles, face painters and pony rides to clay shooting, penalty shoot-outs, tractor rides, craft stalls, prize stalls, food, drink and much more.

The day is being coordinated by the grandad of a local little boy named Roux, who was sadly diagnosed with an incredibly rare brain tumour at just 4 weeks old. Since then, Roux has endured years of treatment, spent much of his life in hospital and undergone 15 neurosurgeries to date. Throughout this incredibly difficult journey, OSCAR's Paediatric Brain Tumour Charity reached out to Roux's family and have been a huge pillar of support ever since. They have provided sibling support for Roux's older brother, funded vital therapies for Roux and, more recently, funded a specialist bed to ensure he can sleep safely at home.

As a small charity, every penny raised truly makes a difference. All proceeds from the event will go directly to OSCAR's to help them continue their incredible work supporting children and families facing a brain tumour diagnosis.

Tickets are £5 per person and, to help plan numbers for the day, they are encouraging tickets to be purchased in advance where possible.
