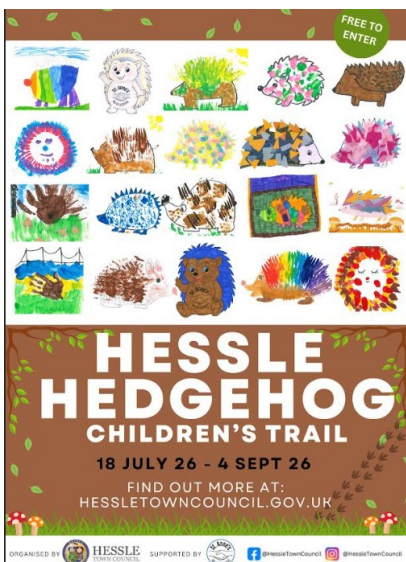
### Hessle Hedgehog Train—18/07/2026 - 06/09/2026

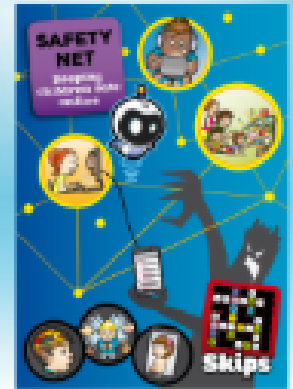

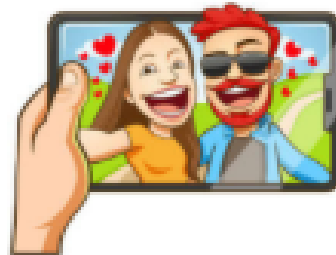
